**A river's story:** The Colorado River is fed by glaciers and snowmelt from Wyoming and Colorado, flows 1,700 miles and falls 14,000 feet on its way through Colorado, Utah, Arizona, Nevada and California before it reaches the Gulf of California. An exhibition of photos and artifacts called "Moving Waters: The Colorado River and the West" is part of a seven-state project that examines how people live on and off the river.
